NOW calling the Pitt County Skywarn Net. This is your net control station.

My name is _____ and my location is _____. The Pitt County Skywarn Net meets on the third Monday night of each month at 21 00 hours local time on frequency 147.090 using the W4GDF repeater located in Greenville, NC. This Skywarn Net takes the place of the usual Pitt County Emergency Communications Net only for this third Monday night of the month. This is a directed net. All stations are invited to participate in the net and its activities. Is there any Emergency traffic, Priority traffic, or severe weather reports? Please call now. (Pause)

We will now stand by for regular check-ins. Each station should check in alphabetically according to the first letter of your call suffix, that is, the first letter following the number in your call sign. Please give your call stated phonetically, followed by your name, location, and weather spotter number if you have one. Informals may be requested, but they will not take place until after the net is closed.

Are there any mobile stations wishing to check into the net. (Pause)

Stations ALPHA through KILO call now. (Pause)

Stations LIMA through SIERRA, call now. (Pause)

Stations TANGO through ZULU, call now. (Pause)

This is (call sign) with the Pitt County Skywarn Net. Are there any additional check-ins ALPHA through ZULU? (Pause) Pass any listed traffic at this time,

As a reminder, if this had been a Skywarn Net in active mode, the National Weather Service would be looking for reports of severe weather such as dime size hail, tornadoes, funnel clouds, rotating wall clouds, damaging winds > 50 mph, flash flooding, and as requested by the National Weather Service.
